

Queries with insulation

Spec of building : 8m x 4m single storey detached

External walls: Single skin with 145mm x 45mm

Roof: Flat roof with 'Furrings' then warm roof with 18mm OSB/3 100mm Celotex & 18mm OSB/3 on top
(finish will be sarnafil or epdm)

Floor: concrete oversight / then 100mm celotex & screed

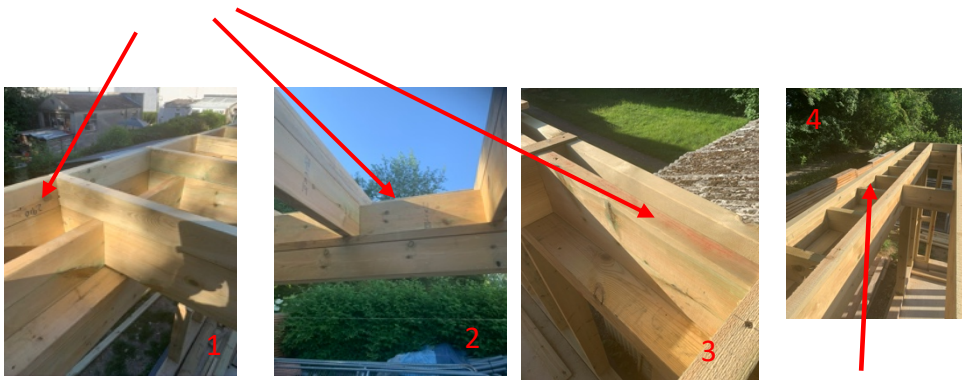
Insulation Eaves etc : Queries

Side walls

Either end of joist run is noggled, on top of the wall plate (pictures 1-3) however the overhang was cut right back for tighter fit of fascia as its adjoining neighbours.

This is why their's smaller gap see (picture 3)
